Nursing program acceptance requires 1) an overall GPA of 2.80, 2) a science GPA of 2.50 (no science grade less than a C), and 3) a TEAS score of Proficient or higher, and TEAS science score of 52.1% or higher.

*Behavioral Science: Students are strongly encouraged to take PSY210 General Psychology.

**Elective: The following are recommended electives: BIO115 Medical Terminology (2hr); PSY218 Abnormal Psychology (3hr); PSY310 Developmental Psychology (3hr); HEA310 Community Health (3hr); HEA316 Substance Abuse Education (3hr); HEA410 The School Health Program (3hr); NSG299/399 Nursing Medical Missions: Haiti; NSG396/496 Field Laboratory; NSG397/497 Practicum or Internship. If you have questions, please ask your advisor.

- 2. Do not alter the sequence of courses without consulting with your academic adviser as not all classes are offered every semester.
