Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Test Schedule

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS®) measures basic essential skills in the academic content area domains of reading, mathematics, science, and English and language usage. There are 170 questions in 4-option multiple-choice format. Students have a total of 209 minutes to complete the 4 content areas. Please be aware – calculators are ***not*** authorized for this test.

The TEAS test is a requirement for admission to the Nursing program. The TEAS test will be administered on the following dates at the location designated. Students must bring a debit/credit card to pay for the assessment on the day of the test. As of this date, **the cost is \$70**. Please bring an official form of personal identification on the day of the test (i.e. Driver's license or other picture ID). **NOTE:** Students not seeking admission to the Nursing program at FHU may incur an additional fee.

If you cannot make any of the above dates, you do have the option to take the TEAS assessment remotely. However, please be aware, because of remote proctoring, this option is more expensive. You can also choose to take the assessment at another institution; however, again, the cost is likely to be greater.

When registering for remote testing or at a different location, you need to be sure you choose Freed-Hardeman University as the institution you want the scores sent to.

In either case, if you do not take the assessment on any of the FHU scheduled dates, you need to be sure that your final assessment report, with your scores, gets sent to Dr. White (cjwhite@fhu.edu).
